In an effort to provide both convenience and the most recent advances to their patients, the doctors utilize a CEREC machine to fabricate porcelain crowns and fillings.

“We invested in this technology to broaden the spectrum of what we can offer our patients,” says Dr. Jeff Scheich. “The CEREC allows us to restore teeth with more conservative procedures and, in most cases, eliminate the need for multiple appointments.”

Each operatory also houses a computer,



which is used for digital imaging, electronic medical records and entertainment for the patients, who are encouraged to use the computers to watch movies, shows or concerts.

STRESS-FREE CONVENIENCE

Castle Pines Family Dentistry strives to take the hassle out of dental visits by seeing patients of all ages. This allows a family to come to one convenient location.

“We know how busy today’s families are,” says Dr. Stephanie Scheich. “We feel

it saves time when everyone in a family can come to one office for their dental needs.”
